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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE VII, SECTION 31-120 OF ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 5757 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI.

**WHEREAS,** Article VII, Section 31-120 of Zoning Ordinance No. 5757 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri, contains provisions relating to the off-street parking of vehicles in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Marshall desires to modify said provisions of said ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Article VII, Section 31-120, Subsection D., Paragraph 2. of Zoning Ordinance No. 5757 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri, is hereby amended by deleting the current language and replacing it with the following:

- 2. In Zoning District C-2, the minimum number of required off-street parking spaces and the access driveways thereto in all newly developed off-street parking areas shall be paved.
- **SECTION 2.** Article VII, Section 31-120, Subsection D., Paragraph 4. of Zoning Ordinance No. 5757 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri, is hereby amended by deleting the current language and replacing it with the following:
  - 4. All newly developed off-street parking areas, and the access driveways thereto, in Zoning Districts C-1, R-1, R-2, and R-3 shall be paved.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed. In all other respects, the Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri shall remain unchanged.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

**SECTION 5.** Should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE A STATE BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MARSHALL AND THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR A GRANT PROJECT RELATED TO THE MARSHALL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, the City of Marshall (õCityö), through Section 116 of the Federal Airport and Airway Safety and Capacity Expansion Act of 1987, and certain amendments thereto, which created the State Block Grant Program, later made permanent by the Federal Aviation Reauthorization Act of 1996, has applied for a sub grant under said Program; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (õCommissionö) has been selected by the Federal Aviation Administration (õFAAö) to administer the State Block Grant federal funds under said Program in the State of Missouri; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has agreed to award funds to the City with the understanding that such funds will be used for the project identified in a certain State Block Grant Agreement.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Mayor of the City of Marshall, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of said City a State Block Grant Agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission for the provision of grant funds to the City of Marshall, Missouri, for the purpose of updating the City of Marshall Airport& Master Plan and Airport Layout Plan, collectively identified as Project No. 19-018B-1 in said Agreement.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and approval.
