**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF TAXES ON
ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION IN THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, FOR
THE YEAR 2021**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied on all property subject to taxation in the City of Marshall, Missouri, for the year 2021, the sum of fifty eight seventy two (.5872) cents on the one hundred dollar valuation thereof as returned by Assessor and the Board of Equalization for said year for General purposes.

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied on all property subject to taxation in the City of Marshall, Missouri, for the year 2021, the sum of twenty five thirty nine (.2539) cents on the one hundred dollar valuation thereof as returned by the Assessor and the Board of Equalization for said year for the purpose of creating a special fund to be known as the "Park Fund" to be used for the maintenance of free public parks.

SECTION 3. There is hereby levied on all property subject to taxation in the City of Marshall, Missouri, for the year 2021, the sum of three ninety three (.0393) cents on the one hundred dollar valuation thereof as returned by Assessor and the Board of Equalization for said year for the purpose of creating a special fund to be known as the "Band Fund" to be used for the purposes as directed by the City Council. This levy is made under authorization by the vote of the people of Marshall, Missouri, on April 3, 1934, and reaffirmed in April, 1938.

SECTION 4. There is hereby levied on all property subject to taxation in the City of Marshall, Missouri, for the year 2021, the sum of fifteen zero nine (.1509) cents on the one hundred dollar valuation thereof as returned by the Assessor and the Board of Equalization for said year for the purpose of creating a special fund to be known as the "Library Fund" to be used for the establishment and maintenance of a public library. This levy is made under authorization by the vote of the people of Marshall, Missouri, on April 3, 1934, and reaffirmed in April, 1938.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to extend on the tax books of the City of Marshall, Missouri, for the year 2021, the taxes as in this ordinance provided, and when said taxes are so extended, said tax books shall be by the City Clerk delivered over to the County Collector for collection of the taxes herein provided and levied, and the County Collector shall by said City Clerk be charged with the respective amounts of such taxes shown by said tax books.
